Netball

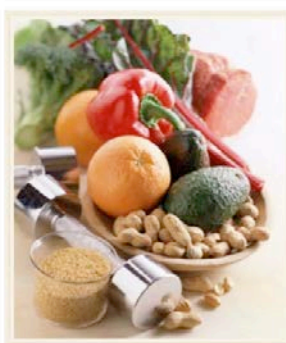
Netball this year has been very successful with a large number of teams making it to the semi finals of their respective grades.
