

Alert Level 2

Bus Information from BOP Regional Council

If your regular school bus is a blue Bayhopper school bus:

- No Bee Card required
- No loading restriction (will carry a full seated and standing load)
- No face covering required
- Schools are required to keep a bus roll

If your regular school bus is operated by a yellow Bayhopper vehicle:

- Bee Card required
- Most are limited to a full seated load; some routes are still limited to 20 passengers
- Face coverings are required for anyone aged 12 and over **(note that we are clarifying this position with the Ministry of Health)**
- Schools are required to keep a bus roll

If your regular bus to school is a yellow Bayhopper urban bus (eg route 1, 36 etc.):

- Bee Card required
- All urban buses are limited to 20 passengers
- Face coverings are required for anyone aged 12 and over
- Students are encouraged to record their travel via the QR codes provided in each vehicle, or the sign-in sheet on the Baybus website.

We ask that parents wait at the bus stop with their child just in case they are unable to get on a bus and/or make alternative arrangements to get their child home after school if required.
