



YEAR 7 IN-ZONE PĀPĀMOA ROTARY SCHOLARSHIP 2025 APPLICATION FORM

General Information

1. All details of the applicant will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.
2. Two levels of scholarships will be awarded each year:
 - **Level A scholarships** these have a value of \$1000 and can be used for uniform, subject material or fees for as long as the student is enrolled at Pāpāmoa College
 - **Level B Scholarships** these have a value of \$500 and can be used for uniform, subject material or fees as long as the student is enrolled at Pāpāmoa College.
3. A maximum of 20 in-zone applicants will be short listed at the start of Term 4. They will be required to attend a testing day. This day will involve academics, leadership, creativity and problem solving. Short listed applicants will be notified in writing of the time and date of the day.
4. A final short list of students will occur once the results from the testing day are collated, and an interview with the applicants and their families will follow. Notification of the time and date of the interview will be in writing.
5. Consideration will be given to learning attitudes, academic ability, involvement in co-curricular activities and any special family circumstances when awarding scholarships.
6. Successful scholarship recipients will be notified in writing within 2 weeks of the interviews being completed and will then have to notify the college in writing of their acceptance.
7. Payment of \$1000 for Level A scholarships will be paid in three equal installments of \$333.00 at the start of each year from Y7 - Y9, this will be credited to an account in the student's name at the college. This fund will then be used for the above purposes for as long as the student is enrolled at Pāpāmoa College. This could include the purchase of material fees, school fees, external exam fees, school trips and camps and other educational costs at the discretion of the Principal. Similarly for Level B scholarship recipients, the value of their scholarship will be credited to an account in the student's name at the college.
8. Pāpāmoa College will liaise with the Pāpāmoa Rotary Club and the successful Level A recipient's school to have the scholarship presented by a Rotarian and the Pāpāmoa College Principal at a suitable function at Pāpāmoa College.
